PMC discussed the new bar hour changes, stating that the change was made to bring hours more in line with other messes across the

	CAF, and that it was a Base Command decision to make that happen
6.	Open Floor
	PMC opened the floor to any questions or concerns from the membership.
	S1 Baker asked the PMC if the mess could subsidize the Bar for cheaper drink prices. PMC said that it was the Mess is not allowed to subsidize the Bar prices.
	S1 Jovanoski commented on the quality of PSP bar staff and asked if the Mess had any say in bar staff. PMC stated the role of PSP in messes CAF wide and that bar staff are unionized and fall under PSP purview.
	Question was asked if here was a higher authority/command that can veto any mess decision. PMC explained that the Base Commander/Base Administration CO oversees all decisions made by the CFB Halifax messes, and they have the authority to veto a decision made by the Mess if those decisions don't align with the CAF.
	Question was raised to reduce mess dues. PMC stated they the mess currently has some of the lowest dues CAF wide and explained the breakdown of where every dollar is spent. Additionally, the PMC explained the Mess is has been spending every dollar that has been coming into the Mess.
	There was a question if the Mess could have drink tickets or have the use of a chit. PMC explained if the membership wants to put some money on the bar then they are allowed but the PMC is not allowed to "Ring the Bell"
	Member asked if the Mess could pay to have a Gazebo set up in the smoke pit on base, PMC said no, as the smoke pit is not part of the Mess.
	Member asked why do we have to pay mess dues? PMC explained that it is in CAF legislation and that every CAF member is part of a Mess and every member will pay Mess dues.
	S3 Ryan asked if the Mess could limit Karaoke to maybe every other week and bring back showing the UFC events. PMC said that they could do that, the reason behind not showing as many UFC events was that members didn't show up to watch the events.

Questions about possibly have a poll for upcoming events PMC said that they would entertain a poll to see how many members would show up to a Mess event. Question was raised if the Mess could purchase season tickets for the upcoming Halifax Mooseheads Season, the Halifax Wanderers, and Halifax Thunderbirds sports teams. PMC said the Mess already buys tickets for the Mooseheads and that they would investigate purchasing tickets for the other teams. Member asked if they Mess could buy different/more flavours of Pizza Pockets. PMC will investigate getting more of a variety. Question was asked about purchasing more video games for use by the membership. PMC will investigate but stated that the mess does buy them and they usually are broken within a month, and that the membership must start policing each other to respect the items that the mess purchases.
