TO LEARN WHAT STEPS YOU NEED TO TAKE FOR YOUR PET AND DESTINATION COUNTRY.





DETERMINE YOUR OPTIONS FOR TRANSPORT BASED ON THE SIZE OF YOUR PET AND YOUR ACCOMMODATIONS ON ARRIVAL.





IF TRAVELLING WITH YOUR PET (CABIN OR BAGGAGE) WHEN YOU HAVE YOUR TICKETS FROM BGRS, CONTACT THE AIRLINE DIRECTLY ASAP TO ENSURE THEY CAN ACCOMMODATE YOUR PET ON THE FLIGHT(S). BGRS WILL BE ABLE TO CHANGE FLIGHTS WITH NO PENALTY WITHIN A CERTAIN PERIOD AFTER ISSUING THE TICKETS.

ONCE YOUR FLIGHTS AND DEPARTURE DATE ARE CONFIRMED, CONTACT YOUR VET TO COMPLETE THE REQUIRED EXPORT CERTIFICATE. ONCE YOU HAVE YOUR VET APPOINTMENT, CONTACT CFIA TO SECURE AN APPOINTMENT. THE PAPERWORK IS ONLY VALID FOR 10 DAYS ONCE SIGNED BY YOUR VET.





REVIEW WHAT YOUR NEW COUNTRY
REQUIREMENTS ARE FOR PETS, INCLUDING
NECESSARY VACCINES AND PAPERWORK.
CONTACT YOUR VET TO ENSURE THEY ARE
FAMILIAR WITH THE EXPORT FORMS.

MAKE SURE TO HAVE A VALID RABIES VACCINATION CERTIFICATE AND MICROCHIP INFORMATION FOR EVERY PET YOU OWN.





CHOOSE THE MOST CONVENIENT /
APPROPRIATE FLIGHTS FOR YOUR
SITUATION / NEEDS AND COMMUNICATE
WITH BGRS. EACH AIRLINE MAY HAVE
DIFFERENT PET CARRIER REQUIREMENTS.
