STEP INTO SUMMER!

We know that the last few months have been challenging and looking forward to summer with limited childcare options is overwhelming, but with online school wrapping up its time to step into summer and mix things up with some fun! The following activities focus on enjoying the warm weather and playing outside but some can be easily brought indoors for a rainy day.





TIN CAN BOWLING

Grab some cans and a ball and let your kids have some fun! Kids love knocking things over so embrace it with this fun simple game! Start a tournament even to get the competition started!





WATER BALLOON PINATA

Tie a rope across your yard, tie full water balloons too it and watch your kids try and break them!





MARBLE RACE

Cut a pool noodle in half to create 2 tracks! Let your kids decorate the track and watch them race marbles down it!

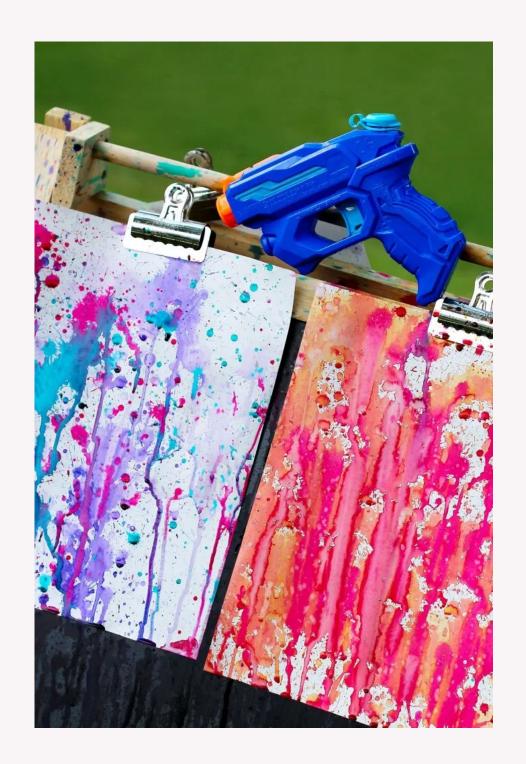


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SQUIRT GUN ART

Fill squirt guns or spray bottles with liquid watercolors (or water and washable paint) and let your kids squirt a masterpiece!





BUBBLE PAINTING

Add some food colouring to your bubble liquid and blow your bubbles onto paper to make your masterpiece!



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CAR WASH

Arm your kids with sudsy water and sponges and let them free to wash their bike, outdoor toys, etc!





BODY

Part of the fun of summer is letting go a little! Let your kids paint their bodies with washable non-toxic paint and then hose them down or let them run through the sprinkler!







Think of all the activities your kids love that make you cringe thinking about the mess and bring them outside! Kinetic sand, water orbs, playdoh slime, crafts with glitter, etc!





OUTDOOR TENT

Set up an outdoor tent to inspire imaginative play or reading outdoors! Use the one you usually use indoors or create a simple one with a flat sheet, tape, hula hoop and twine!





WALL DROP

This activity is easily adapted to be simple or complex, for inside or out! The basics are to secure tubes of some kind to a wall to drop something through! Inside use toilet paper and paper towel tubes and drop pom poms!

Outside use things like pool noodles and recycling (think 2L pop bottles) and pour







MUD CAFE

Fill a large bin with dirt (a storage bin or small kiddie pool will work!). toss in some baking utensils and you're all set! Let your kids serve you their mud creations!
