Become familiar with your destination country's cost-of-living, currency, and exchange rates.
Read the <u>Budgeting Considerations Checklist</u> and complete the <u>Budget Comparison Calculator</u> (Don't forget to set goals and regularly track your income and expenses!)
If you would like to use an online budget tool, you can use the SISIP <u>Home Budget Calculator</u> .
Ensure you have an Emergency Fund in your budget to help with unexpected expenses.
Share banking/services logins/passwords with your spouse/partner, if applicable.
Get familiar with the <u>Canadian Armed Forces Relocation Directive and</u> other benefits you may have access to.
Learn about <u>Taxes While OUTCAN</u> , and speak to a Chartered Professional Accountant about your OUTCAN situation.
Ensure you have a detailed list of your current bank accounts, credit cards, lines of credit, loans, etc including contact information if you need to make changes or renew cards while OUTCAN.
Research banking practices and services in your destination country.
