



What is Special Needs?





Bottom Line Up Front (BLUF)

- Special Needs is a complex matter
- Not much is known, systematically, about Special Needs in the Canadian Armed Forces (CAF) community
- Relocations due to a military postings cause increased stress on CAF families with Special Needs
- No single organization has the capacity to tackle this matter alone



What Do We Know?

Demographics

- Limited information
- ~ 8% of personnel have a child with special needs

Accessing and Navigating Services

- Lack of awareness of services
- Difficulty navigating services

Impact on Children

Relocation causes interrupted social, health and education support systems = negative impact on child development

Impact on Caregivers

- Lower levels of mental wellbeing
- Higher levels of depression
- Lower selfefficacy
- Less support from family (both sides)


Relocation and Satisfaction with CAF

- Extra responsibilities upon relocation = more stress
- Spouses of CAF member with child with special needs = less likely to have employment = greater resentment toward CAF



How is Special Needs Defined?

- CFMWS, CAF, Provinces/Territories, Canada
 - No common definition
 - No common terminology
- Why is Special Needs difficult to define?
 - Goal:
 - To be inclusive and eliminate discrimination
 - Result:
 - Broad and illustrative (vague) definitions



Special Needs, Complex Needs,
Neuro-divergent, Exceptionality,
Diverse Needs, Developmental
Needs, Intensive Needs, Disability....

What About Special Needs Policies and Services?

- Policies/regulations and service provision
 - CFMWS, CAF, Provinces/Territories, Federal
 - Founded on vague definitions not equitable across the different organizations and provinces/territories
- Overall: Complex nature



What Has/Is Being Done for Special Needs?

- Environment scan
 - Overall: Quite a bit being done about Special Needs
 - Within MFS, CFMWS and MFRCs
 - Past work
 - Current work (on-going)
 - CAF/Department of National Defence
 - Defence community organizations
 - Provincially/territorially
 - Federally
 - Other governmental and non-governmental organizations (NGOs)





What Are the Known Challenges?

- Support for CAF families exists widely, but mainly on a case-by-case basis
- Military lifestyle (Relocation) creates increased stress on CAF families with special needs
- No single organization can tackle this alone
